ELIGIBILITY

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals in advanced stages of life-limiting illness with life expectancy of 2 years or less. • Care can be provided alongside any curative or aggressive treatment. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals with a life-limiting illness with a life expectancy of 6 months or less. • Individuals who are no longer seeking aggressive or curative treatment. |
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TREATMENT

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bridges the gap between curative treatment and end-of-life care while supporting patients and families with their physical, emotional, psychosocial and spiritual needs during advanced stages of illness. • Durable medical equipment and supplies are NOT covered by Palliative Care. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improves quality of life through comfort measures while meeting the physical, emotional, psychosocial and spiritual needs of patients and families in their end-of-life journey. • Durable medical equipment and supplies are covered by Hospice Care. |
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VISIT FREQUENCIES

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum visits every 30-45 days. Plan of care and visit frequencies are individualized and based on needs. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum weekly nursing visits. Plan of care and visit frequencies are individualized and based on needs. |
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CARE TEAM

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Led by Palliative Nurse Practitioner. May also include Licensed social worker and chaplain as needed. • Patients remain under the care of their primary physician. • Patients can continue with all specialty providers and services. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Led by attending provider, hospice physician and Nurse Case Manager. May also include Certified Nursing Assistant, Licensed Social Worker, Chaplain, Music Therapist & Volunteer. • Patients can elect an attending physician or nurse practitioner of their choice to be part of their hospice care team. • Patients discontinue seeing specialty providers related to the terminal prognosis. |
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PAYMENT

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visits are billed through Medicare part B or private insurance in a similar way a physician visit is billed. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All care and services are covered by the Medicare hospice benefit, traditional Medicaid and most private insurance policies. |
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
